Regulations (2005) core capacities of Sri Lanka World Health Organization, 2025-06-24 The Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka has a long and impressive history of strong leadership and commitment to International Health Regulations (IHR) (2005) compliance and health security. Health security in Sri Lanka dates back to 1897 when the Quarantine and Prevention of Diseases (QPD) Ordinance was enacted. Since the implementation of the IHR (2005) in 2007, Sri Lanka has made steady progress in implementing and developing IHR core capacities. In June 2017, Sri Lanka became one of the first countries in South-East Asia to conduct a Joint External Evaluation for IHR (JEE-IHR), using JEE Tool version 1, and prepare a National Action Plan for Health Security (NAPHS) for the five-year period of 2019-2023. In addition, Sri Lanka completed an IHR-Performance of Veterinary Services (PVS) National Bridging Workshop in February 2023, where the country's human and animal health services reviewed their current collaboration strengths and gaps in key technical areas and developed a joint road map to improve work and coordination at the animal-human interface in the prevention, detection and control of zoonotic diseases. Sri Lanka also conducted a national workshop on strategic assessment of emergency risks using the Strategic Tool to Assess Risk in May 2023 to derive a national emergency risk profile, annual risk calendar, and recommendations to select and order the capacity-building interventions to be included in the next NAPHS, based on the priority actions stemming from this second JEE exercise.

Beginning thousands of years before the state of Missouri existed, Olson recounts how centuries of inventiveness and adaptability enabled Native people to create innovations in pottery, agriculture, architecture, weaponry, and intertribal diplomacy. Olson also shows how the resilience of Indigenous people like the Osages allowed them to thrive as fur traders, even as settler colonialists waged an all-out policy of cultural genocide against them. Though the state of Missouri claimed to have forced Indigenous people from its borders after the 1830s, Olson uses U.S. Census records and government rolls from the allotment period to show that thousands remained. In the end, he argues that, with a current population of 27,000 Indigenous people, Missouri remains very much a part of Indian Country, and that Indigenous history is Missouri history.
