Application Process and Important Deadlines

Completing the FAFSA

Students must submit a FAFSA each academic year to be considered for federal, state, and institutional aid. The FAFSA opens annually on October 1, and early submission is encouraged to maximize aid eligibility. The BGSU school code must be entered on the FAFSA to ensure the university receives the application data.

Additional Documentation

After FAFSA submission, some students may be selected for verification, requiring the submission of tax returns, income statements, or other financial documents. The BGSU Office of Financial Aid provides clear instructions and deadlines for submitting verification materials to prevent delays in aid processing.

suspension of financial aid eligibility.

Verification Process

Verification is a federal requirement that involves confirming the accuracy of information reported on the FAFSA. Selected students must provide documentation such as tax transcripts, W-2 forms, and household information. The BGSU Office of Financial Aid guides students through this process to ensure compliance and timely aid disbursement.
